A model for rural health care




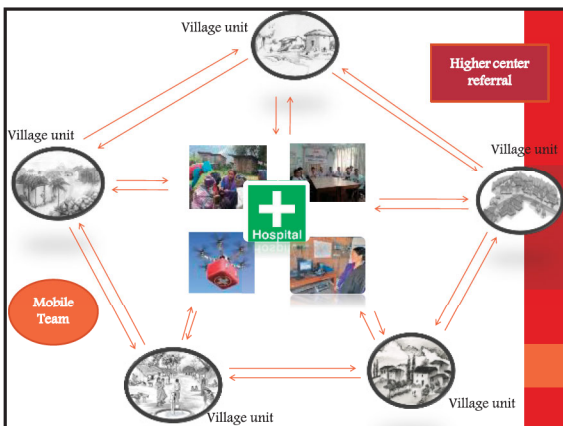
Applied to..
