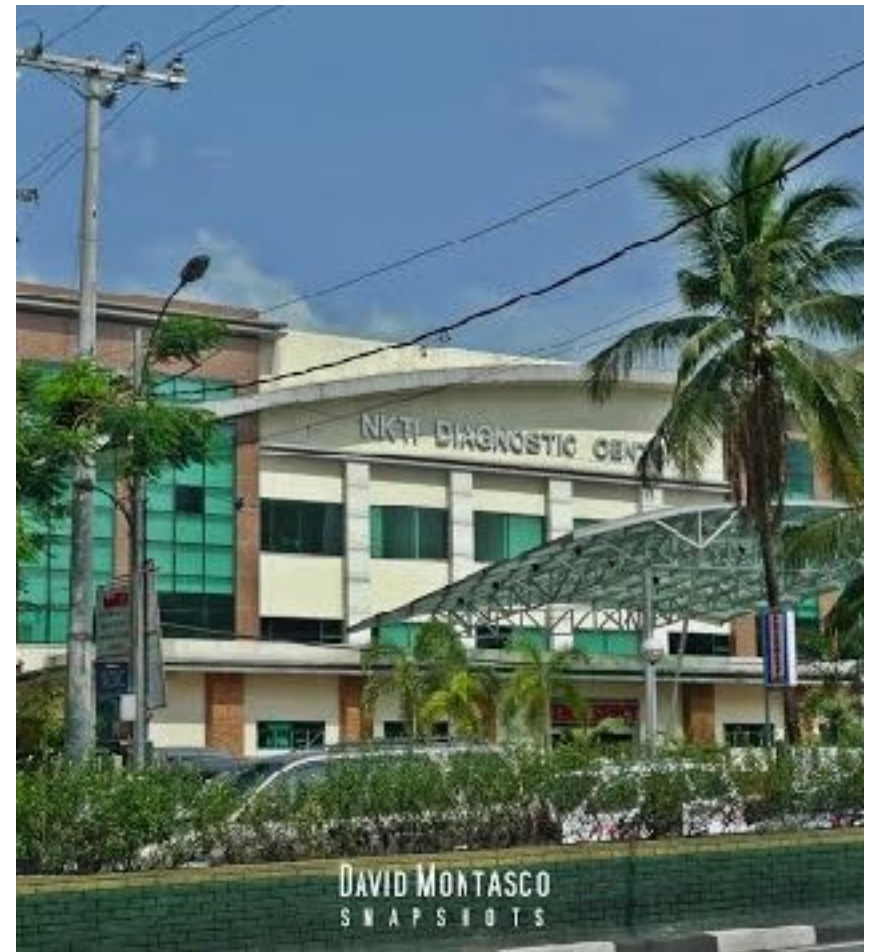
National Kidney and Transplant Institute

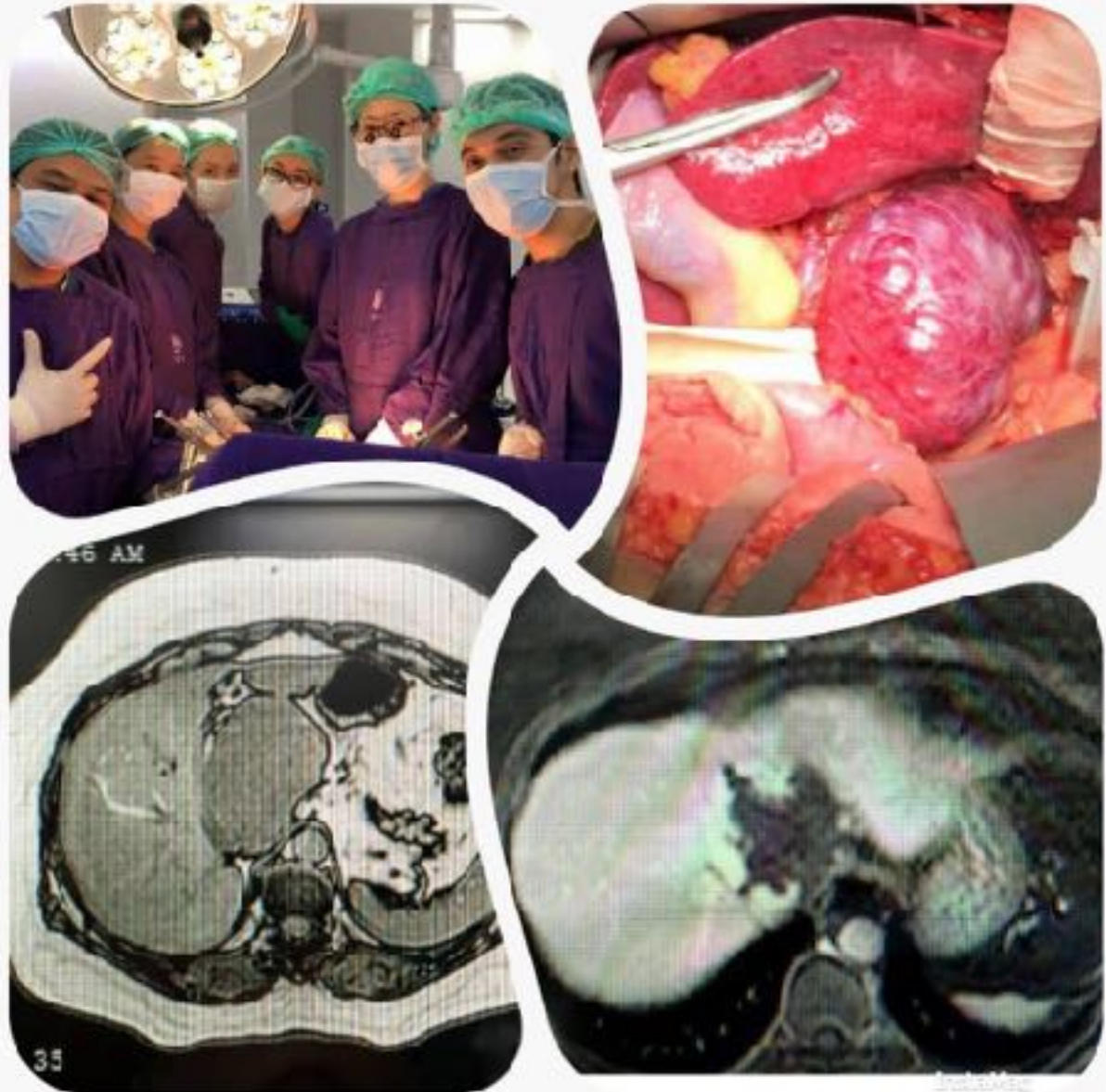

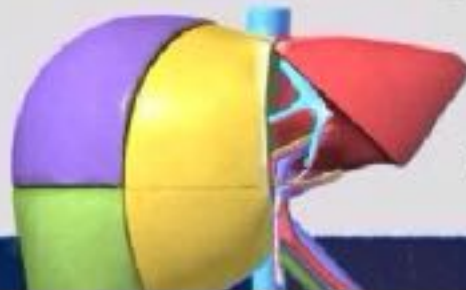

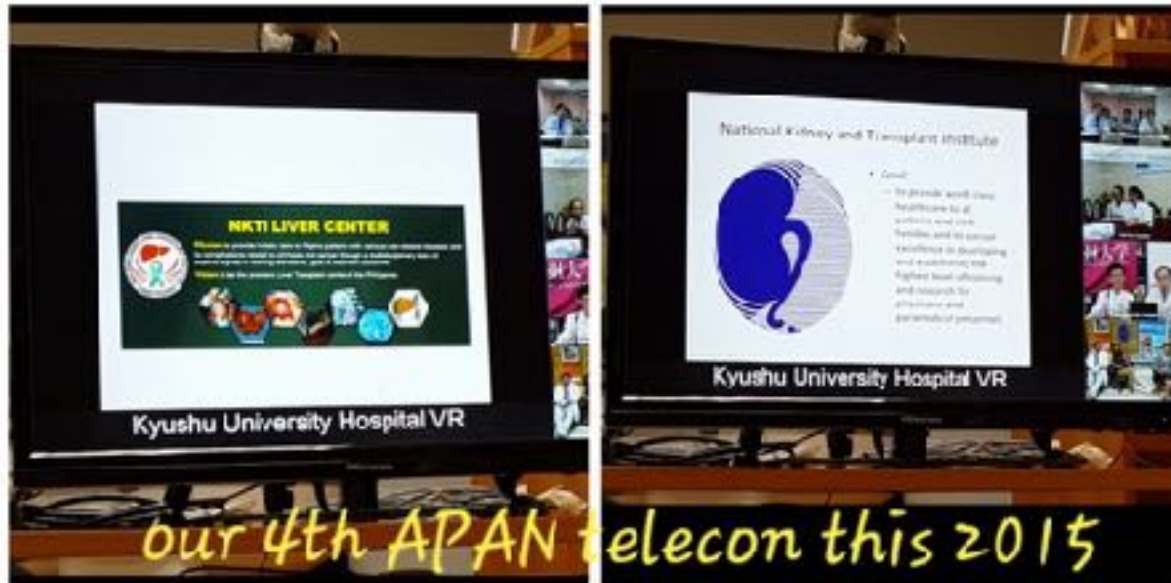
