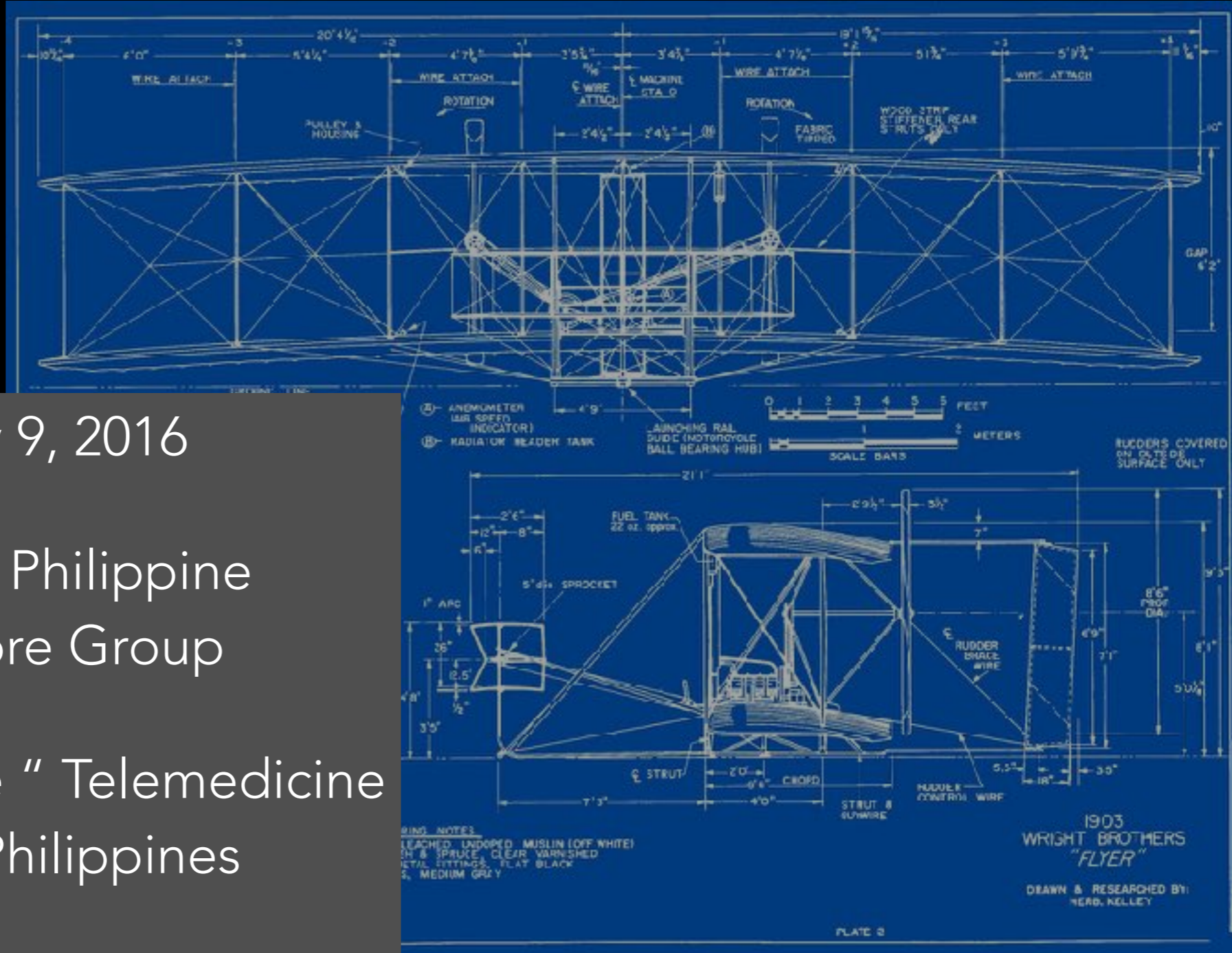

- Establishment of different protocols for the teleconferences and the network.

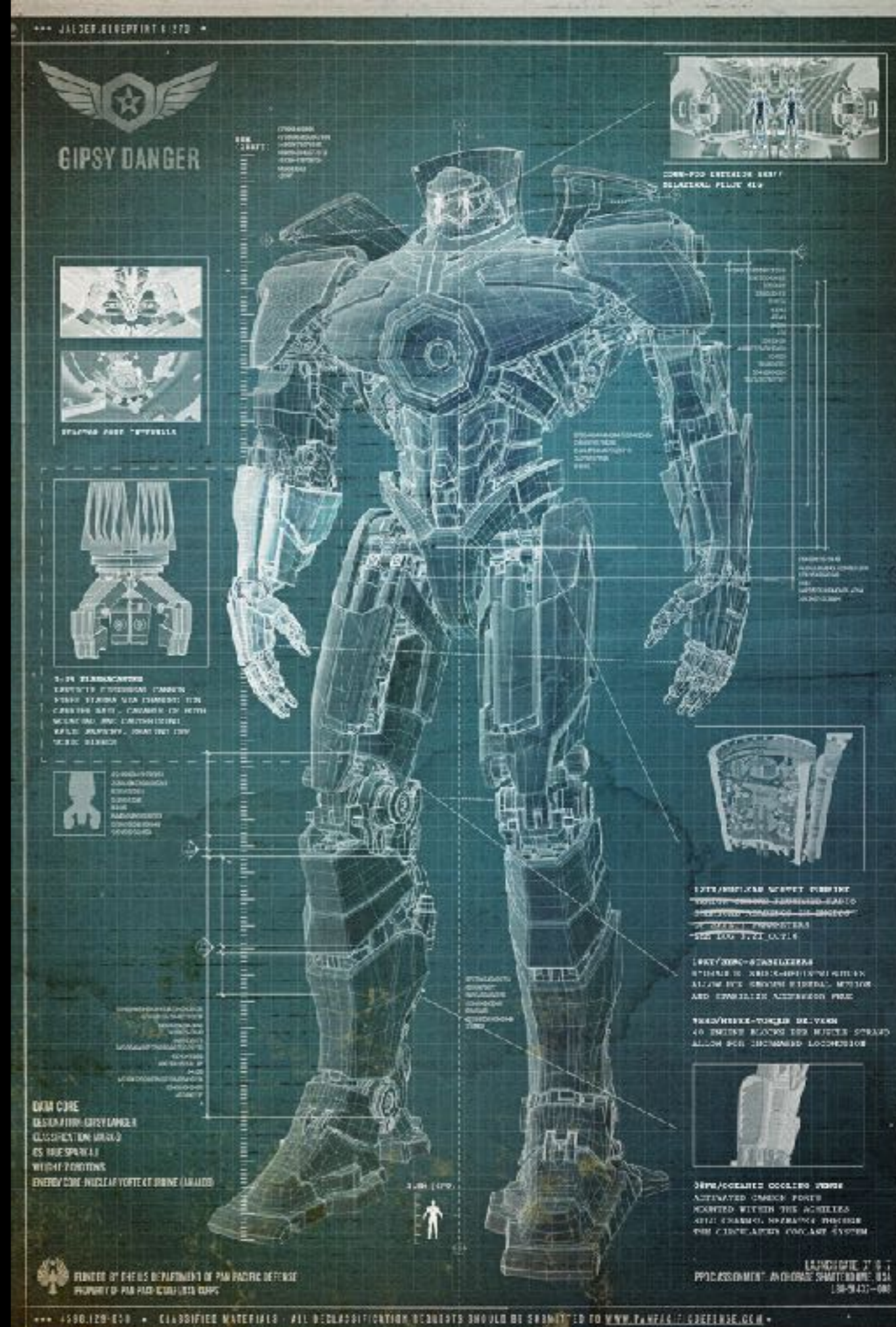




# TIMELINE: (CONTINUATION)
