







Relevance of TELEMEDICINE for Indonesia

- Indonesia is an archipelago, some patients find it difficult to travel to clinics, hospitals, or doctors' offices for any number of reasons.
- ► Inadequate infrastructure in rural/district hospitals
- Large number of in/outpatients requiring referral for specialized care
- Low-availability of Health Experts/specialist in district/remote hospitals
- Shortage of adequate opportunities for training or continuing Medical Education for Doctors in Rural/ Remote Health facilities
- Remote healthcare services and technology are quickly becoming common-place for healthcare.
- ► Telemedicine enables practitioners to evaluate, diagnose and treat patients remotely using the latest telecommunications technology.






Survey Study on The Role of Telemedicine in Clinical Setting ¹


- In medical education, telemedicine usually done in the apprenticeship model through telementoring, where trainees "learn by doing" under the guidance of experienced mentors.
- ► The aim is to know the role of telemedicine in medical education based on clinical setting in our hospital.
- ▶ A survey using web questionnaire given to the medical students, residens and doctors who work at Internal Medicine Department Saiful Anwar General Hospital Malang, after joining the teleconference
- ▶ Total 273 respondent, analysed the information regarding aspects of clinical practice, education and awareness on telemedicine.


Web Based Telemedicine Survey








Have You Ever Heard About Telemedicine?

Radiology; sending images from radiographers to radiology specialists


Anatomical phatology; specialists see preparations on a computer screen

Participating in lectures via TV link up when attendance is not possible


download teaching materials from a website if you miss a lecture or for revision

Observing surgical procedures in classrooms through relays directly from the operating room (live demo)


Make medical education available to a wider group of students

Patients should be motivated to have access to medical information available on medical sites so that they have knowledge of their health conditions


Telemedicine combined between the ease of public access to health information will make a healthier population in the future

The use of Telemedicine can improve health services, especially in terms of disease prevention




