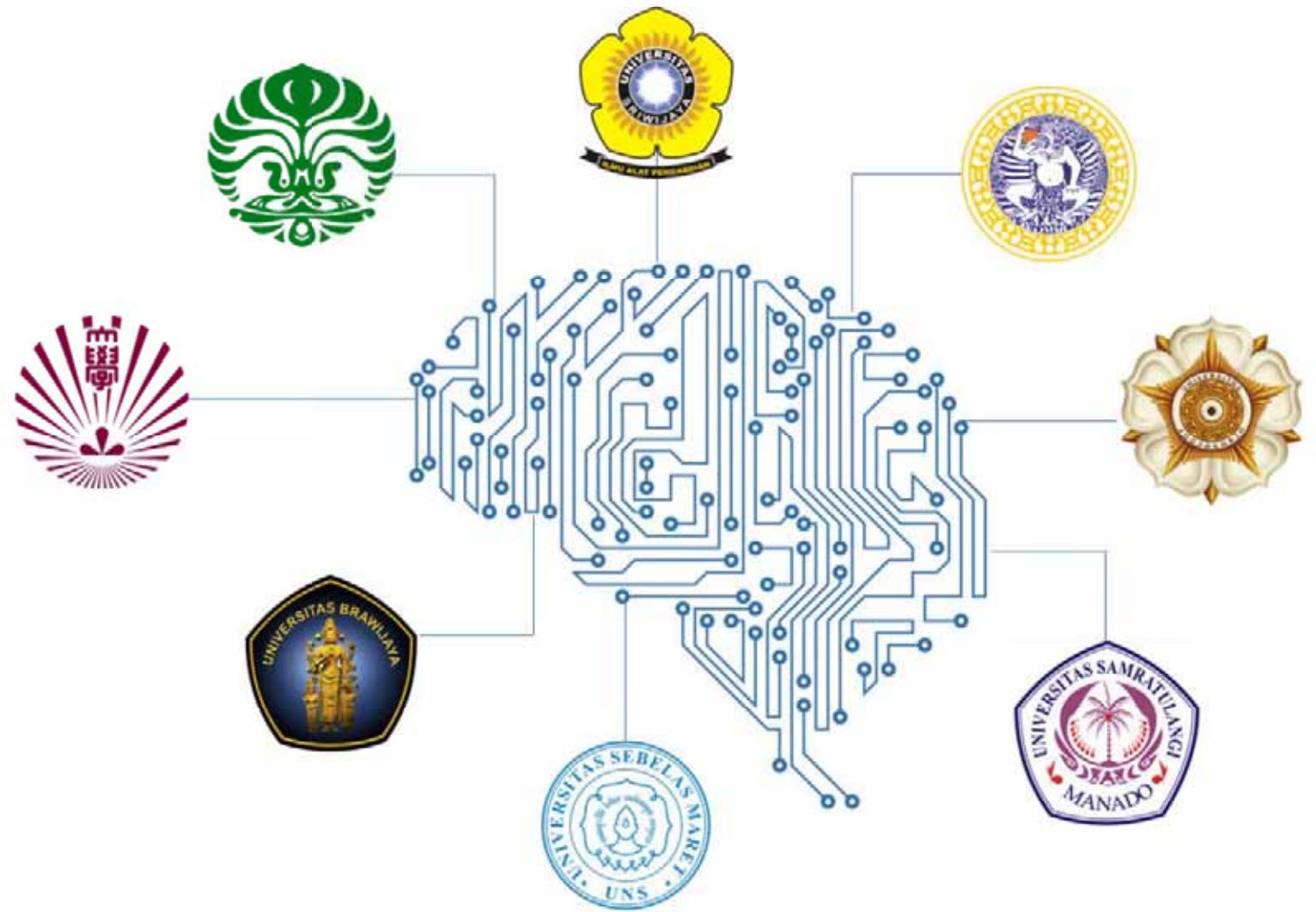


# Indonesia Neuroimmunology Teleconference
