
BPKIHS: Telemedicine Programme

Telemedicine programme : started May 2015 and continue running

expanded to : 6 sites; (4 districts; 3 administrative zone; 2 province; focused on eastern part of Nepal)



- working on remote places which are not far from the BPKIHS by distance but very difficult to access health facility.
- Sindhuwa : 79 Km from BPKIHS but very hard to get public transport
- Fikkal (Suryodaya PHC): 145 KM far from BPKIHS and most of the patients can not afford private hospital which are in between PHC and BPKIHS.



 Bhojpur: 143 KM far from BPKIHS but takes more than 6 hour.

There is one district hospitals in between but no adequate facilities for patient treatment. Most of patient refer to BPKIHS (and other private Hospitals)



- Himalayan Times writes a news about the road to bhojpur:
- The under construction road section became muddy after the rains, obstructing passengers of Bhojpur and Sankhuwasabha from smooth travel. The travellers are forced to walk some distance in their journey after the vehicles they are traveling on get stuck in the mud at various parts of the road section.

- Diversity: Can have diversity of cases for the consultants.
- Followup: Patients can save time and money for minor ailments for which they were previously referred.

- Awareness: Looks hi-tech for the people who are not used on computer and internet. It has to address by the people who are working on digital device.
- Motivation to Health worker: Health Personnel working on small village have a lot of work. Sometime telemedicine becomes least priority



Telemedicine: challenges

- Government Policy: There should be a a treatment guideline for the telemedicine patient.
- Lack of easy accessible teleconferencing software
- Lack of online EMR (Electronic Medical Record system) for telemedicine patient.
