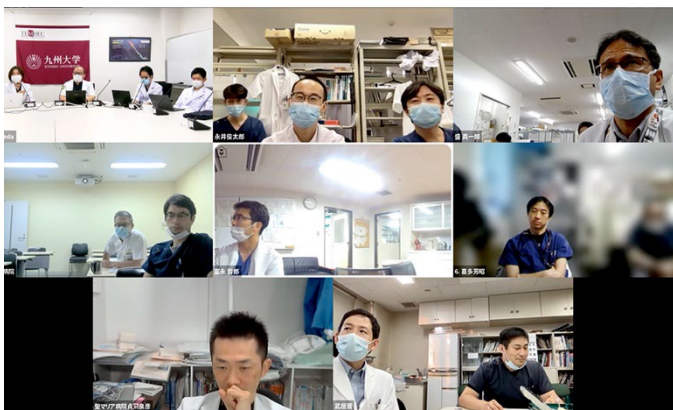

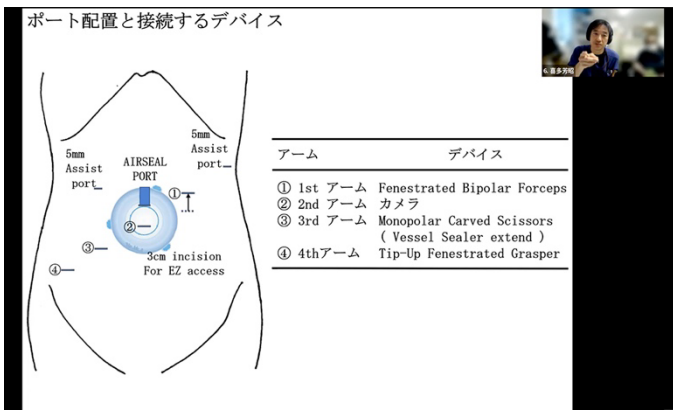
Monitor shows connected sites.

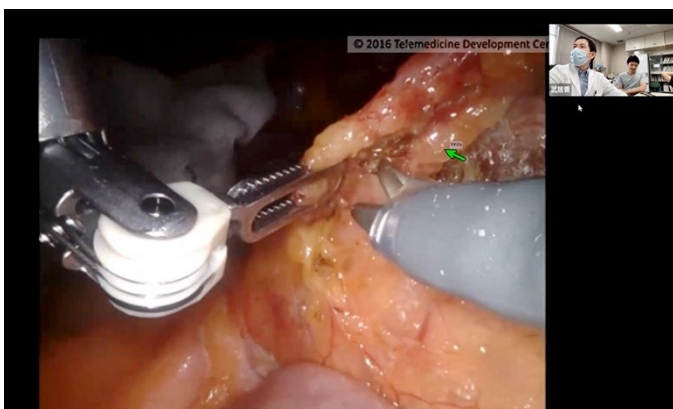

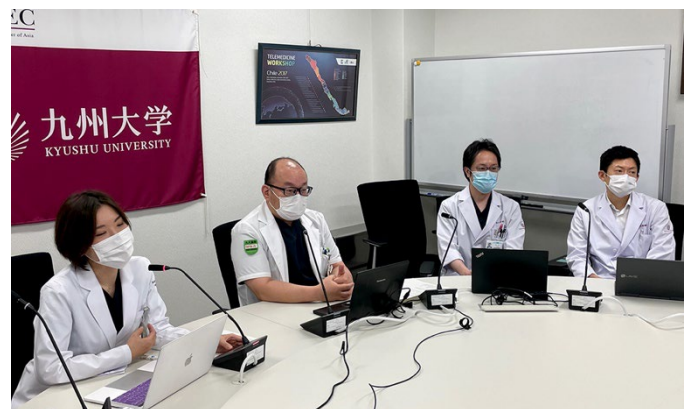
