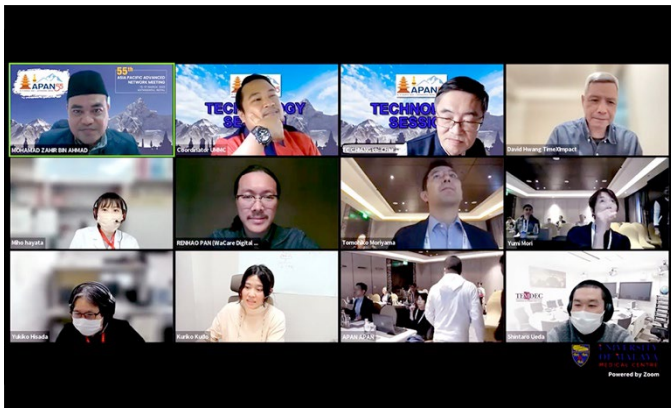

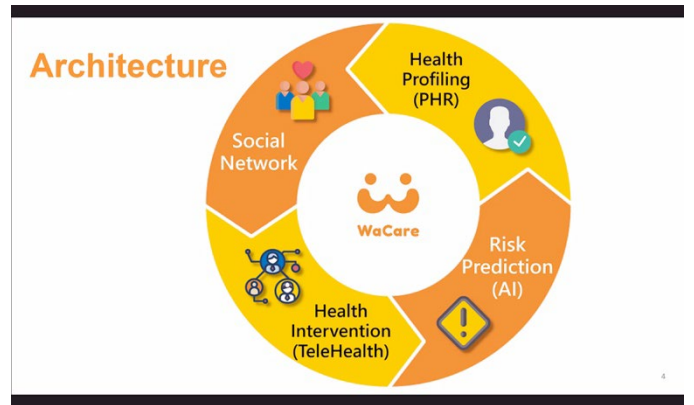
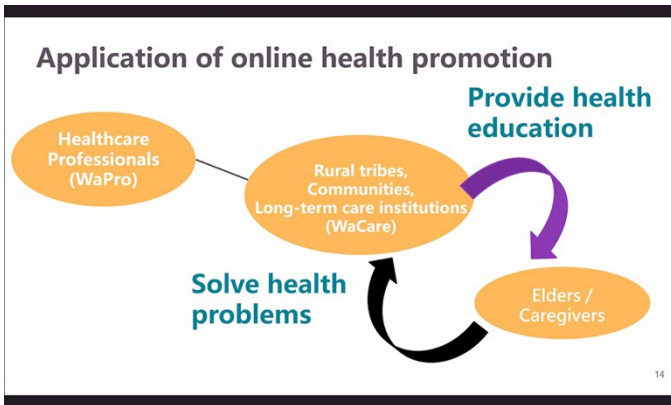


Monitor shows connected site
