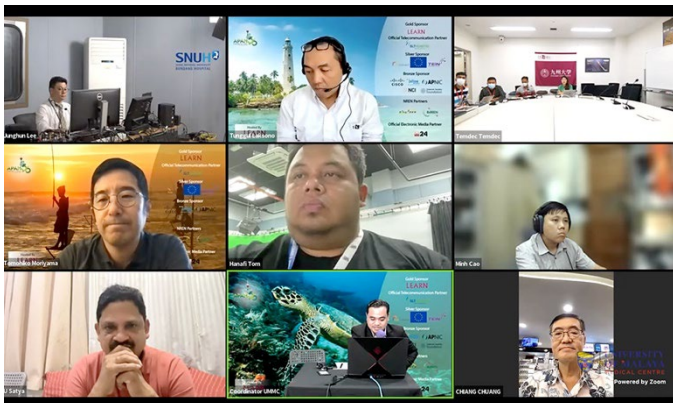

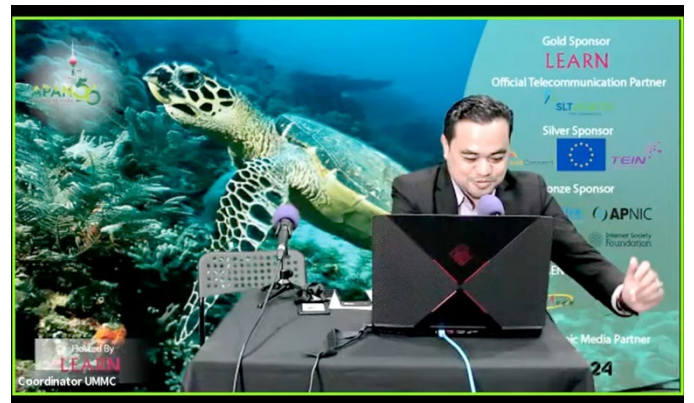
【 Comments 】

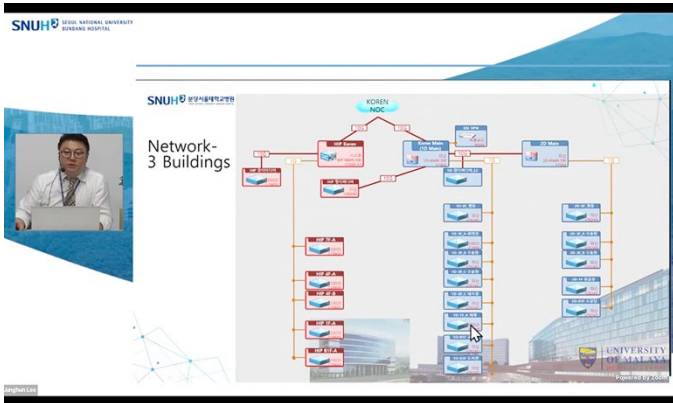
Monitor shows connected sites

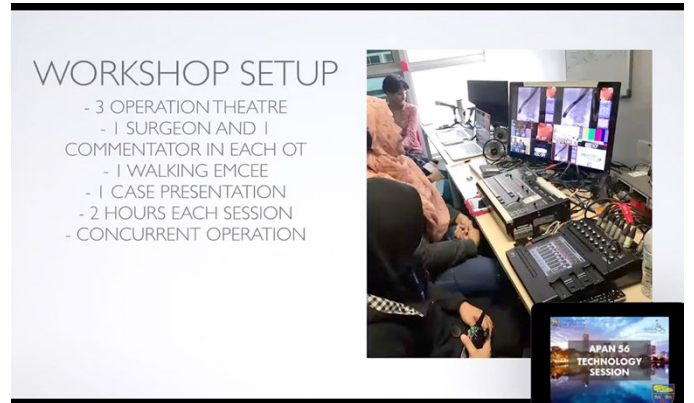

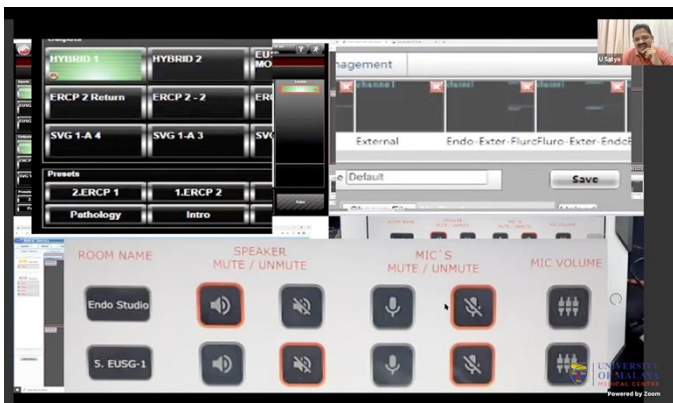
