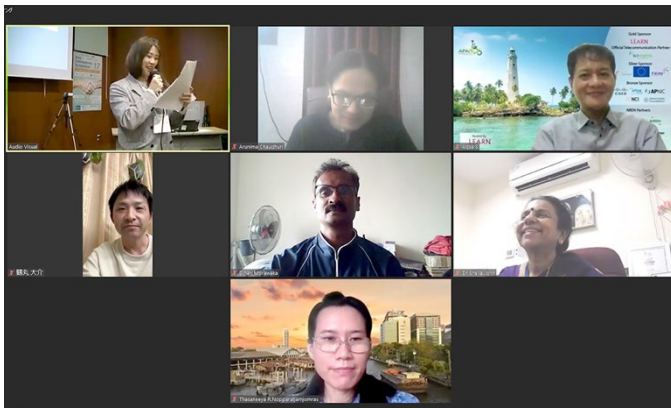

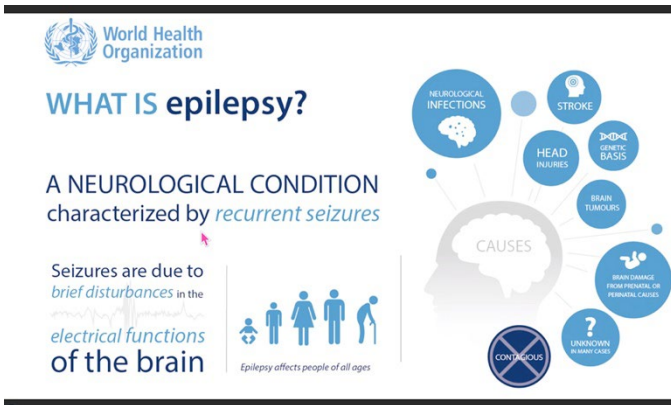
Monitor shows connected sites

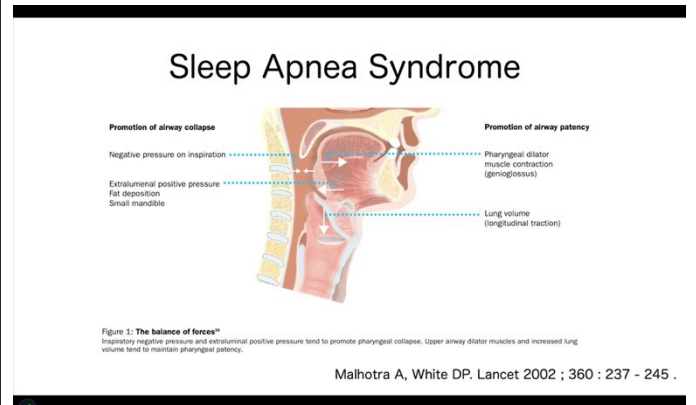
